This is a scam that customers have reported a few times this year. We are passing this along, so you are aware of this "pop up" scam.

"Pop-up" Scam Messages Reported

Scenario. . . A person logs into their computer and as soon as they are successfully logged

in, there is a pop-up window that comes up on their computer screen claiming

to be from Microsoft. It says something along the lines of, "Security Risk, Financial and Personal Information Compromised". The message may include the last four digits of the customer's account number and where they bank. When it pops up onto the computer screen it gives them a number to call claiming to be the bank number, along with a link

When the person calls the number that is given to them, someone answers claiming to be from "Fidelity Bank". The person on the phone says that several large unauthorized purchases have hit their account, and their information was compromised. The person on the phone tells the caller not to trust people

to click on that will download something to help them out with their issue.

at the bank because they don't know who the "bad banker" person is. Then the usual happens. . . The scammer tells the caller/bank customer to give them their banking information or sometimes log into their Bank Account so that they can help them to take the money out of their bank and wire it so that they can move it

somewhere "safe" in the meantime. If the customer actually wires the money, the scammer will quickly drain the

wire, the receiving bank has no legal obligation to return the funds. As a reminder:


